The City's Yard Waste and Tree Debris Disposal Site is located at the City's Materials Management Site at 27887 Highway 'U'. The Yard Waste and Tree Debris Area is open 7 days per week from 7:00 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. excluding City Holidays.

YARD WASTE PICK-UP ON DEMAND SERVICE

Effective October 3, 2016, the City began a new Yard Waste and Tree Debris Pick-up on Demand Service. Similar to the Bulky Item Pick-up on Demand Service each residential property will receive two 2 cubic yard pick-ups as part of the fees paid for residential trash service each calendar year. During the 2 free pick-ups should the material being collected exceed 2 cubic yards, the property owner will be charged \$23 for each additional cubic yard of material collected and disposed by the Sanitation Department. For a third or additional Yard Waste and Tree Debris Pick-up On Demand Service calls made to the same residence in the same calendar year each cubic yard of material will cost the property owner \$25 per cubic yard.

TWICE-A-MONTH YARD WASTE & TRIMMING COLLECTION SERVICE — AVAILABLE FOR A NOMINAL FEE

Effective October 3, 2016, the City began providing a new bi-monthly yard waste & trimming collection service to citizens of Sedalia as an optional service at an additional fee. The service is provided from March through November. The cost of the service is \$2.00 per month and a senior discounted rate of \$1.70 per month is available for those individuals age 60 and over.

The City is divided into two (2) groups and collection occurs the first four (4) Mondays of each month with collection occurring as follows:

- First and third Mondays — residents east of Ohio
- Second and fourth Mondays — residents west of Ohio

For purposes of this service, yard waste consists of grass clippings, leaves, tree limbs and other vegetative debris resulting from the normal grooming and pruning of lawns and landscapes. Yard waste must be placed in biodegradable paper bags; however, sticks and tree limbs may be bundled tightly with string. Sticks and tree limbs must not exceed a maximum of 3 feet in length and each bundle should weigh no more than 25 pounds.
