 - A. Dan Youngblood, 1315 S. Quincy, is requesting a four way stop at the intersection of W. 14th Street and S. Quincy Avenue. He has concerns about the intersection and the school children in the area. This request was tabled from the prior meeting so staff could collect additional information.
 - B. Gary Blake, 3257 Cunningham Drive, is requesting the stop signs be removed from Clarendon Rd. at Southwest Blvd. changing this intersection to a two way stop, stopping Southwest Blvd. only. The stop signs are not needed and interrupt the flow of traffic on Clarendon Rd. This request was tabled from the prior meeting so staff could collect additional information.
- V. New Business
 - A. Stephen Galliher, 200 S. Osage Avenue, is requesting parking restrictions on Stone Creek Road. He would like “30 minute parking” on the west side of Stone Creek Road starting from the north side of the drive entrance to Casey’s north 143 feet, to the south side of the fence around the water tower.

He would like “no parking” on the west side of Stone Creek Road starting at the north end of the 30 minute parking going north 485 feet, ending on Brianna Blvd.

He would like “no parking” on the east side of Stone Creek Drive from E.16th Street north 241 feet.

He would like “no parking” on the east side of Stone Creek Drive starting 50 feet south of the corner going north to 50 feet around corner ending on Brianna Blvd.

The reason he is requesting the parking restrictions is when vehicles are parked on the west side of Stone Creek Drive people who are pulling trailers have a hard time turning into the storage Stone Creek Drive.

- B. Greg Harrell, Sedalia Fire Department, 200 S. Osage Avenue, is requesting no parking on both sides of the proposed new road, Ammon Drive, on both entrances from 12th Street, affecting the corners only. This will allow the fire truck to make the turns on the proposed road when it is constructed.
- C. Jeff Lehman, City of Sedalia, 200 S. Osage Avenue, is requesting no parking around the corners in the Crescent Creek Addition, Crescent Creek Addition Park 2, Lehi Addition, and on Matz Circle. This will allow emergency vehicles to make the turns on the roads in these areas.
- D. Tina Schroeder, 824 W. 6th Street, is requesting the removal of two handicapped parking signs in front of 823 W. 6th Street. The resident who lived in the home and used the spaces no longer lives there so the signs are not needed.
