Arbor Day 2018 and Mini-Park Dedication



An Arbor Day event was held at noon on Friday, April 6, 2018 at the mini-park located on the northwest side of the intersection of Clarendon Road and the Katy Trail in Sedalia, Missouri.

In recent days, the Katy Trail @ Clarendon Road mini-park has become home to 78 trees provided by KCP&L. Project Coordinator John Meehan says the planting of the trees is only the beginning of an on-going effort by a committed group of community organizations to expand the offerings at the mini-park and provide visitors to Sedalia with a shaded area to take a break and enjoy the community. Future plans for the mini-park include a restroom facility with solar lighting, a play area, and a hitching post area for horses.

This project was made possible by support from the Sedalia Lions Club, Sedalia Rotary Club, Missouri State Fair, Missouri Department of Natural Resources and their Division of State Parks, Katy Trails, Inc., KCP&L, MC Power Companies, Menards, the Sedalia Democrat and the City of Sedalia and its' Tree Board and the Sedalia Parks and Recreation Department.

As part of the Arbor Day Celebration, the City's Tree Board and City staff distributed trees to local businesses provided by the Missouri Department of Conservation. This year, trees were provided to Interstate Studio and Publishing, Maxion Wheels, Waterloo Industries Inc. and Bothwell Regional Hospital. Approximately 1,000 seedlings were distributed. Sedalia is proud to be designated as a Tree City USA for its ninth year!
