PUBLIC NEWSLETTER FOR THE CITY OF SEDALIA

The 2017 Citizens Surveys are being collected and many citizens have stated they are not aware of the twice-a-month yard waste and trimming collection service.

The City has a yard waste drop-off site; however, if you are unable to transport your debris to the site, a leaf, yard and tree trimming collection service is available from March through November. This bi-monthly collection service is available to citizens of Sedalia as an optional service at an additional fee.

The fee per month is \$2.00 and a senior discounted rate of \$1.70 per month is available for those individuals age 60 and over. Biodegradable paper bags for leaf and yard debris disposal can be found at general merchandise retail

stores and hardware/home improvement stores
