New Sedalia Animal Shelter Est. 2016

The City of Sedalia and four-legged friends at the Sedalia Animal Shelter will soon say goodbye to Shelter Manager Andrea Martin as she furthers her career closer to her Oklahoma friends and family.

In the two years that Andrea has invested her skills with the City of Sedalia, the animal shelter has seen many changes both in the management of the shelter and its physical location. On July 1, 2015, the City of Sedalia took over management of the Sedalia Animal Shelter at 2900 W. Main Street.



At this facility, personnel cared for community pets with access to 30 dog kennels and 32 cat cages. In just one year (July 2015-July 2016), the new shelter management adopted out 312 dogs and 142 cats. They also returned 236 dogs and 7 cats back to their owners

and transferred 21 dogs and 16 cats to rescue facilities.

On October 22, 2014, Ms. Sue Heckart with the Heckart Family Foundation unveiled plans to build a new state-of-the-art animal shelter that would house 47 dog kennels and 97 cat cages. On July 5, 2016, Ms. Heckart transferred the newly built Sedalia Animal Shelter to the City of Sedalia.



On November 4, 2016, staff and adoptees opened for customers at the new shelter located at 2420 S. New York Avenue. During 2016, the Sedalia Animal Shelter placed 519 pets through adoption, returned 251 lost pets back to their families and transferred 38 animals to rescue.



“Through the two years that Andrea has been part of the City of Sedalia, she and her staff have experienced more transition in their department than most City employees with much lengthier years of service,”stated Mayor Galliher. “I know we all wish Andrea the very best in her future endeavors and we are very thankful for everything she has accomplished for our community.”
