## 2019 Recycling Permits for Pettis County Residents



A reminder – City residential recycling services are available to individuals residing outside the corporate city limits of the City of Sedalia for an annual fee of \$64. This provides individuals not residing in Sedalia with an alternative to landfilling reusable materials accepted by the City of Sedalia for recycling. While recycling is the environmentally "right thing to do," the City is required to offset its costs of collecting, transporting and having the materials processed for reuse through collection of a fee for the service. The recycling fee is required as the costs for collection and processing of recyclable materials routinely exceed the moneys generated from sale of such material for reuse. The form and annual recycling fee must be paid and the decal placed on the individual's vehicle prior to any material being delivered to the recycling location.

The form and fee may be hand delivered to or mailed to City of Sedalia Finance Department, 200 S. Osage Avenue, Sedalia, MO 65301. After payment of the applicable fee and upon receipt of the recycling decals, individuals may begin delivering residential

recyclable materials to the City of Sedalia's Materials Management Site at 27882 Highway U, Sedalia, Missouri. Each household paying to recycle materials will receive two (2) recycling decals to be displayed in the rear window of the vehicle(s) delivering recyclables to the drop-off site.
