Spring will soon be here and for many of us that means it's time to start thinking about cleaning out unwanted items in the garage or attic.

Please be aware that the City of Sedalia has an ordinance on file which contains the regulations for garage sales (Chapter 44, Sections 44-120 to 44-124) and listed below are some basic Questions & Answers you might need to know:

**How many sales can I have in a year?** - No permit shall be issued to any person more often than 3 times in any one calendar year; nor shall any permit be issued for any sale to be held on the same premises more often than 3 times in any one calendar year.

**How many days can I have a sale?** – No sale for which a permit is required shall be held or scheduled for more than 2 calendar days.

**How much does a permit cost?** – They are free of charge.

**What information is needed for a permit?** - Information contained on a permit is the name of the person having the sale; the physical address of the sale; date(s) of sale; and a contact phone number.

**Where do I go to obtain a permit?** Permits may be obtained in person at the City Clerk's Office or you may also apply online on the City's website at [www.cityofsedalia.com](http://www.cityofsedalia.com). Once on the website, click on the "City Departments" tab, "City Clerk" and then "Garage Sale Permit Application". Once on the application, fill out the required information and click submit. When the application is submitted, an email is sent to the City Clerk's Office for processing and once the application is processed, a permit will be emailed to the requestor.
